Re: Westchester County Airport

Dear Honorable County Executive Latimer and County Legislator Kaplowitz:

As you are aware, we wrote to you on June 22, 2018 (“June 22 Letter”) to (a) reiterate the significant concerns of the Town of New Castle as to the current and future operations of Westchester County Airport and (b) ensure that the Town of New Castle remains informed of any activity related to the airport as set forth in the June 22 Letter and consistent with the standard inherent in the County’s “Good Neighbor” policy which is the symbol of how this administration has communicated it would work with the residents and communities of Westchester County.

We would have hoped that that the recent draft document for the Request for Proposals for the Supplement to the Westchester County Airport Master Plan (“RFP”) and an application by Westchester County dated June 20, 2018 for permits to be obtained for future work at the airport would have both fallen under this policy. Our ability as a town board to represent the residents of New Castle is greatly impacted by our ability to have advance knowledge of events taking place relating to potential actions at the airport.

And while we are also grateful that the County has taken steps to ensure that a New Castle resident now has a seat on the Airport Advisory Board, the request to provide notice to New Castle of the types of actions listed in the June 22 Letter is separate from any information that may or may not be provided to any member of the Aircraft Advisory Board. We are also aware that the members of the Airport Advisory Board have made a number of information requests of the County so that they can better perform their duties and we would request that the County help facilitate all such requests to the fullest extent possible.

Thank you for your time and attention. We look forward to hearing from you.
