RE: Public Notice to All Residents Regarding Road Paving and Microsurfacing in Town of New Castle for the Period Beginning August 11, 2022.

Dear Resident:

The Town of New Castle plans on 2-3 weeks of road paving and microsurfacing. Road paving is tentatively scheduled to begin Monday, August 15, 2022 and last through Friday, September 2, 2022. Paving will take place Monday through Friday, from 7:00 am to 5:00 pm. Roads to be paved at this time include:

Road microsurfacing is tentatively scheduled to begin Thursday, August 11, 2022 and last through Friday, August 12, 2022. Microsurfacing will take place Thursday and Friday, from 7:00 am to 5:00 pm. Roads to be microsurfaced at this time include:

Residents will experience temporary disruptions to traffic and access as paving operations commence. Residents are asked to refrain from parking on these streets as paving proceeds.

The precise scheduling of work depends upon weather conditions and the proper operation of paving equipment. Therefore, your patience and understanding are appreciated. Keep in mind that it is possible that rain events or paving equipment issues may push back the paving schedule a day or two. Paving will be preceded by key cuts to the intersections and to some driveways where they are considered beneficial.
