

1. Authorization to Set Public Hearing Regarding a Local Law to create Chapter 86 of the Town Code requiring the use of face masks and face coverings to prevent the spread of COVID-19

Whereas, the Town Board of the Town of New Castle hereby sets a Public Hearing on a local law to create Chapter 86 of the Town Code requiring the use of face masks and face coverings to prevent the spread of COVID-19 to be held on Tuesday, July 14, 2020 at 7:00 p.m. or as soon thereafter, via videoconference and teleconference and in person, if permitted.

2. Resolution Requiring the Wearing of Face Masks and Face Coverings on Public Property

Council Member Katz moved, seconded by Deputy Supervisor Saland to adopt the following resolution:

RESOLUTION REQUIRING THE WEARING OF FACE MASKS AND FACE COVERINGS ON PUBLIC PROPERTY

WHEREAS, on January 30, 2020, the World Health Organization designated the novel coronavirus, COVID-19, outbreak as a Public Health Emergency of International Concern; and

WHEREAS, on January 31, 2020, the United States Health and Human Services Secretary Alex M. Azar II declared a public health emergency for the entire United States to aid the national healthcare community in responding to COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, on March 7, 2020, pursuant to Section 28 of Article 2-B of the Executive Law, Governor Cuomo issued Executive Order Number 202, declaring a State disaster emergency for the entire State of New York; and

WHEREAS, COVID-19 is a contagious disease that is rapidly spreads from person to person and can be transmitted from people who are infected with the virus, even if they are a-symptomatic or their symptoms are mild; and

WHEREAS, COVID-19 is a threat to the public's health, safety and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the Center for Disease Control and Prevention and the World Health Organization recommend cloth masks for the general public as an effective way to prevent the spread of COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, on April 15, 2020, Governor Cuomo issued Executive Order 202.17 requiring any individual who is over the age of two and able to medically tolerate a face-covering to cover their nose and mouth with a mask or cloth face-covering when in a public place and unable to maintain, or when not maintaining, social distance; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board and the New Castle Recreation and Parks Commission deem it to be in the best interest of the Town of New Castle to adopt additional regulations pertaining to face mask and face covering requirements on town owned property, including the Town's parks, recreational facilities and municipal buildings.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOVLED, that in order to further protect the public health, safety and welfare, the Town Board of the Town of New Castle hereby adopts the following regulations:

Section 1. Individuals present in or on any Town property, including any town park, recreational facility, town building, walkway or plaza must wear protective face masks or face coverings which shall be of sufficient size to cover the nose and mouth of the wearer at all times when unable to maintain, or not maintain a distance of six feet from another person. This requirement shall not apply to any child under the age of two or to anyone who is unable to medically tolerate a face covering.

Section 2. Acceptable face masks or face coverings for COVID-19 include but are not limited to cloth-based face coverings and disposable masks that cover both the mouth and nose.

Section 3. Exceptions:

- a. Individuals are able to maintain a distance of six feet from another person.
- b. Individuals who reside in the same household.
- c. Masks shall not be required to be worn by campers pursuant to the Interim guidance for child care and day camp programs during the COVID-19 public health emergency guidance.
- d. Individuals playing a sport or participating in a fitness class or recreational activity are not required to wear a face mask if individuals are unable to tolerate a face covering for the physical activity and unable to maintain a distance of six feet from another person. Individuals must put a face mask or face covering on as soon as such physical activity has ended.
- e. Individuals are not required to wear a face mask or face covering when they are eating and/or drinking while stationary.

Section 4. Enforcement. The Police Department of the Town of New Castle shall enforce the provisions of this Resolution. Any person who refuses to wear a face mask or face covering as required herein shall be required to leave Town property or other public space.

Section 5. This Rule shall take effect immediately.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall expire upon the adoption of a Local Law by the Town Board requiring the use of face masks and face coverings to prevent the spread of COVID-19.
