TOWN OF NEW CASTLE
PROPOSED LOCAL LAW AMENDING
CHAPTER 123, PART 1, ARTICLE II OF THE
CODE OF THE TOWN OF NEW CASTLE**

A LOCAL LAW to amend Chapter 123, Part 1, Article II of the Town Code concerning Southview Road.

BE IT ENACTED by the Town Board of the Town of New Castle as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 123, Part 1, Article II, Section 5, Subsection A of the Town of New Castle is hereby amended as follows:

§ 123-5 No-parking zones established.

A. Parking shall be prohibited at all times on the following streets or portions thereof as stated:

Allen Place	East	From a point 125 feet south of King Street
Castle Road	East	From King Street to Bischoff Avenue
Crow Hill Road	Both	Entire length
Granite Road	West	From Route 120 to the entrance of Westorchard School
Harriman Road	West	From Sheather Road to a distance of 1,000 feet north
Hawkes Avenue	Both	Entire length
Hidden Hollow Lane (both entrances)	North	30 feet west from Route 100
Hunts Lane	Both	Entire length
Hunts Place	Both	Entire length
King Street	South	From South Greeley Avenue to Allen Place
Maple Avenue	North	For a distance of 80 feet from King Street
Maple Avenue	South	Entire length
North Greeley Avenue	East	From a point 180 feet north of King Street to a point 370 feet north of King Street

North Greeley Avenue	East	From the corner of Maple Avenue south for a distance of 390 feet
North Greeley Avenue	West	From a point 235 feet north of King Street to a point 252 feet north of King Street
Old House Lane	Both	Entire length
Old Pines Bridge Road	Both	West of Washington Avenue
Old Pines Bridge Road	East	From Washington Avenue to a point 650 feet north thereof
Old Shinglehouse Road	Both	Entire length
Orchard Ridge Road	East	From King Street to Crest Road
Pamela Place	North	30 feet west from Route 100
Poillon Drive	East	For King Street to Prospect Drive
Poillon Drive	West	For a distance of 100 feet from King Street
Prospect Drive	East	From the corner of King Street for a distance of approximately 125 feet
Roaring Brook Road	North	From entrance of Horace Greeley High School to the Metro North train tracks
Roaring Brook Road	South	From entrance of Horace Greeley High School to the Metro North train tracks
St. John's Place	East	Entire length
Senter Street	South	A distance of 147 feet from King Street
Smith Street	Both	Entire length from South Greeley Avenue to the Town line
South Greeley Avenue	East	From 10 feet north of the Bell School driveway to 20 feet south of the Bell School driveway
South Greeley Avenue	East	From 10 feet north of church driveway to 20 feet south of the driveway
South Greeley Avenue	East	100 feet south of King Street and Greeley Avenue intersection
South Greeley Avenue	East	From a point 50 feet north of the library driveway to a point 50 feet south of the intersection with Smith Street
South Greeley Avenue	East	From Woodburn Avenue south 75 feet
South Greeley Avenue	West	From the north point of the north approach to the bridge to a point 63 feet south
South Greeley Avenue	West	From midpoint of the intersection of Quaker Street to a point 110 feet north
South Greeley Avenue	West	From the south approach to the bridge to 50 feet south of the intersection with Washington Avenue
Washington Avenue	North	From its intersection with South Greeley Avenue west to its intersection with Old Pinesbridge Road
Washington Avenue	South	Entire length
Woodburn Avenue	Both	West of South Greeley Avenue, including the periphery of the A. H. Smith Memorial Park

Section 2. Chapter 123, Part 1, Article II, Section 5.3 of the Town of New Castle is hereby amended as follows:

§ 123-5.3 No stopping zones established.

No vehicle may be parked, standing or stopped for any purpose of delivery or any other activity in the following zones.

Section 3. Ratification, Readoption and Confirmation

Except as specifically modified by the amendments contained herein, Chapter 123 of the Town Code of the Town of New Castle is otherwise to remain in full force and effect and is otherwise ratified, readopted and confirmed.

Section 4. Numbering for Codification

It is the intention of the Town of New Castle and it is hereby enacted that the provisions of this Local Law shall be included in the Code of the Town of New Castle; that the sections and subsections of this Local Law may be re-numbered or re-lettered by the Codifier to accomplish such intention; that the Codifier shall make no substantive changes to this Local Law; that the word “Local Law” shall be changed to “Chapter,” “Section” or other appropriate word as required for codification; and that any such rearranging of the numbering and editing shall not affect the validity of this Local Law or the provisions of the Code affected thereby.

Section 5. Severability

The provisions of this Local Law are separable and if any provision, clause, sentence, subsection, word or part thereof is held illegal, invalid or unconstitutional, or inapplicable to any person or circumstance, such illegality, invalidity or unconstitutionality, or inapplicability shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, clauses, sentences, subsections,

words or parts of this Local Law or their petition to other persons or circumstances. It is hereby declared to be the legislative intent that this Local law would have been adopted if such illegal, invalid or unconstitutional provision, clause, sentence, subsection, word or part had not been included therein, and if such person or circumstance to which the Local Law or part hereof is held inapplicable had been specifically exempt there from.

Section 6. This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Office of the Secretary of State.

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
